Hot Summer Sun

Lyme & Giardia Vaccinations

If you take your dog camping, hiking, or hunting we recommend that they be vaccinated for Lyme's disease (transmitted by ticks) and Giardia (present in outdoor water sources and causes gastrointestinal distress). Ask our staff more about these vaccines to keep your active friend happy and healthy.
